

PRIMARY ELECTION FILING DATES TO REMEMBER

The 2010 Primary Election is near. **March 9, 2010** is the Deadline to file for county offices. County offices to be elected are;

- ➔ Treasurer
- ➔ Assessor
- ➔ Commissioner
- ➔ County Judge

The County Judge files with the Secretary of State, where Judge Grasty has filed to run for re-election for the non-partisan position. Treasurer Ellen (Nellie) Franklin, Assessor Ted Tiller, have filed to run for re-election for their respective non-partisan offices and Commissioner Jack Drinkwater, Republican, has filed to run for re-election.

February 1, 2010 is the First Day for candidates for precinct committeeperson for respective parties to file declaration of candidacy for primary election with the county clerk.

February 25, 2010 is the Last Day for potential nonaffiliated candidate to register as not a member of a party to meet 180 day requirement for general election.

March 18, 2010 is Last Day for city elections official, county governing body or district elections authority to give notices of measure elections to county clerk for the primary election.

April 27, 2010 is the Last Day to register for the primary Election, if not already registered in Oregon.

Ballots for the primary election will be sent to voters on **April 30, 2010**.

May 18, 2010 is Primary Election day in Oregon.
